HOW TO FILL OUT A TRANSMISSION APPLICATION

Section 1

- 1. Print the name of the executor/administrator as shown on the Grant of Probate, Letters of Administration or Court Order.
- 2. Print the name of the deceased as shown on the Grant of Probate, Letters of Administration or Court Order.
- 3. Check the applicable box beside either:
 - Grant of Probate:
 - Letters of Administration; or
 - Court Order.

Section 2

- 1. Print the name of the deceased as shown on the Certificate of Title.
- 2. If the deceased is the registered owner of property, fill in the legal description or the parcel number shown on the Certificate of Title.
- 3. If the deceased is the owner of an interest registered against the Certificate of Title, fill in the Interest Register Number shown on the Certificate of Title.

How to sign the Transmission Application:

- 1. Fill in the date on the line provided.
- 2. Sign your usual signature.
- 3. Print your name as shown on the Grant of Probate, Letters of Administration or Court Order on the line provided.
- 4. Print your mailing address of executor/administrator, including the postal code. This is the address that will be shown on the new certificate of title.

INFORMATION ABOUT REGISTERING A TRANSMISSION APPLICATION

THE LAND TITLES OFFICE CANNOT GIVE LEGAL ADVICE

To fill out this form, we recommend that you get a copy of the current Certificate of Title. Anyone can obtain a copy of the title to a property at the Land Titles Office or by searching the online Yukon Land Title Registry (YLTR). If you prefer not to use the online YLTR, to ask for a Certificate of Title you must submit a Search request form to the Land Titles Office. You will need the legal description of the property (Lot, Block/Quad and Plan Number) or the current registered owner's name.

You will have to register a certified copy of the court order that names you as the personal representative (executor or administrator) of the deceased person's estate. If the court order was issued by a court outside of the Yukon, you may not be able to file it in the Land Titles Office and you should seek legal advice.

If your documents do not comply with the requirements of the Land Titles Act, 2015, they will be rejected. We will notify you by phone, email or mail to tell you the reasons we have rejected your documents.

Original signatures are required on all documents. Once you have signed the Transmission Application, you should make a copy for your own records.
