In connection with the registration of a lease, assignment of lease, mortgage, financial encumbrance or transfer of land in the Land Titles Office, the condominium corporation certifies that with respect to unit (as shown on condominium plan):	
The unit owner does not owe money to the corporation.	
OR	
The amount the unit owner owes to the corporation, other than an amount paid into court or to the corporation in trust under s. 166 of the <i>Condominium Act, 2015</i> (the Act) is \$ and arrangements satisfactory to the corporation have been made to pay the money owing. This amount may include fines and any costs for remedying a contravention or rules charged against the unit owner or fines and costs for which the owner is responsible.	
The corporation may charge a fee of not more than \$50 for providing this certificate and may refuse to issue the certificate until the fee is paid.	
This certificate must be completed by the condominium corporation and returned to the person requesting the certificate within one week of receiving the request.	
The information in this certificate is binding on the corporation in its dealings with a person who relied on the certificate and acted reasonably in doing so (ss. 186(3) of the Act)
