Labour Force Survey, April 2020



Note: As all Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey data for the territories are three-month moving averages, the full impact of COVID-19 will not be reflected in the LFS data until the March-April-May numbers are released on June 5.

In April 2020, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 2.3%. Canada's unemployment rate for April was 13.0%. Compared to the figures for March 2020, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (21,300) decreased by 400; the number of employed (20,800) decreased by 200; and the number of unemployed (500) decreased by 200.
