
## Labour Force Survey, February 2020

Released by Statistics Canada — March 6, 2020

In February 2020, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.1%. Canada's unemployment rate for February was 5.6%. Compared to the figures for January 2020, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (22,000) decreased by 200; the number of employed (21,100) decreased by 100; and the number of unemployed (900) decreased by 200.
