



Update for Government of Yukon Retirees

Changes to your Group Insurance Benefits Plan, effective April 1, 2024

New premium rates for the Extended Health Care insurance plan will be in effect as of April 1, 2024. Extended Health Care premium rates are adjusted each year to reflect changes in the member group's demographics, use of the benefit plan, cost of medical supplies and services as well as the insurer's expenses.

The Extended Health Care rates will increase by 52.8% for April 1, 2024. The change to premium rates will be reflected on your April 2024 Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) from your bank account.
