Retail Trade, February 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada — April 21, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for February 2020 was \$58.7 million, an increase of \$8.1 million, or 16.1%, compared to February 2019. The February 2020 retail sales figure increased by \$35,000, or 0.1%, compared to January 2020.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 6.5% in February 2020 compared to February 2019, and decreased 2.6% compared to January 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January through February), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$117.3 million. This represents an increase of \$13.1 million, or 12.6%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$104.2 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 5.2% over this time period.
