Retail Trade, July 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada - September 18, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for July 2020 was \$86.7 million, an increase of \$2.2 million, or 2.6%, compared to July 2019. The July 2020 retail sales figure increased by \$4.5 million, or 5.5%, compared to June 2020.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 4.8% in July 2020 compared to July 2019, and increased 1.6% compared to June 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January through July), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$488.3 million. This represents a decrease of \$5.4 million, or 1.1%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$493.7 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales decreased 6.4% over this time period.
