Central registry files

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

Series consists of central registry files of the Yukon Territorial government containing correspondence, reports and memoranda created by federal officials charged with the responsibility of administering the Yukon Territory. The records include original incoming correspondence and copies of outgoing information prepared by the offices of the Commissioner, Gold Commissioner, Comptroller, Registrar and the other agents and officials who managed the affairs of the Territory. These files provide a rich source of information on such subjects as doctor's fees, taxes, homestead land, local elections, roads, the fire department, surveys, schools, mining claims and methods, Indian reserves, postal service, dance halls, gambling, churches, missions, telephones, wireless, courts, permits, ordinances, licenses, hospitals, timber lots, the cost of living, steamships, sewer systems, northern defence, scientific expeditions, customs, aviation, floods, individual companies, diseases, sports, tourism, water diversion, the White Pass and Yukon Railway, cemeteries, the North West Mounted Police, saw mills, and farming, among others.

The central registry system consists of a series of sequentially numbered files. There appears to have been two registry series although a gradual changeover from the main series to the second series occurred under the administration of the Department of Mines and Resources. An overlap of dates indicates this transition period. It was often difficult to determine to which series a particular file belonged. For example, file 466 on the Alaska Highway, which is in the main series, may properly belong in the second series. Conversely, file 20 on Waterfront Leases in Dawson, which may belong in the main series was placed in the second series. (RG91, reels M-2826 to M-2874)

For example, collections of applications were placed with the subject files; bound volumes of copies of regulations and judgments were placed within the register index series. SCOPE AND CONTENT:

Series consists of applications made to the Agent of the Dominion Lands for town lots in Dawson during the Spring of 1898. These applications take the form of a standardized letter to the agent listing the applicant's name, the town lot, a list of improvements made on the property, if any, and often a promise to construct a proper outhouse with a night soil box on the property.

Over time these files have been reorganized on a subject basis so that the original registry numbers are no longer identifiable. A single file may contain individual documents stamped with six or more file numbers. Applications for liquor licenses

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

Series consists of applications which were submitted by individuals or trading companies seeking permission to obtain a license to sell liquor, to obtain a hotel, or to transfer or renew these licenses. The Yukon Territory Act of 1898 invested in the Commission power to license shops and saloons. This proved to be one of the largest sources of income for the territorial government. The application included an inspection report, usually prepared by a North-West Mounted Police Officer. The report describe the establishment [some include a rough sketch] and offer recommendations as to whether the license should be granted. A covering letter from the officer to the license inspector and receipts sent to the application by the inspector are also found on file. The applications are filed alphabetically by name of applicant and a listing is provided in the finding aid.

Files to be reviewed under the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act* are indicated by an asterisk [*]. If the review has been completed, the result is noted: *o = open, *po = partially open, or *c = closed.

In addition to the application the end of this series contains miscellaneous document obtained by the Chief Inspector of Licenses. Subjects include drunkenness charges, and the illegal importation of liquor. There are also various certificates and declarations. These documents have been arranged by name of person or company involved.

Office of the Commissioner

BIOGRAPHY/ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:

Major J.M. Walsh of the NWMP, was appointed the first commissioner of the Yukon (PC 2468, 11 August 1897). The Commissioner (the equivalent of the Lieutenant-Governor in the older North-West Territories) administered the District with a six-person appointed Yukon Council, that included the Judge of the Territory, the Gold Commissioner, the Registrar, the Legal Advisor, and the Superintendent of the NWMP in the Territory. The Commissioner reported to the Deputy Minister of the Department of the Interior. The records in this series, covering the period from 2 October 1899 to 23 September 1902, were created during the tenure William Ogilvie and James H. Ross. William Ogilvie was appointed Commissioner by Order-in-Council in 1898 (PC 1775, 1 July 1898). James H. Ross became the Territory's third Commissioner, his appointment being made on 11 March 1901 (PC 544, 11 March 1901). As a result of the resignation of Ross in 1902, Major Z.T. Wood was appointed acting Commissioner (PC 542, 16 October 1902). Wood was replaced in 1903 when Frederick T. Conglon was appointed Commissioner (PC 306, 4 March 1903).

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

Series contains letterpress copies of outgoing correspondence from the Office of the Commissioner, covering the period from 2 October 1899 to 23 September 1902. The correspondence reflects the wide range of legislative powers assigned to the Commissioner and may deal with such issues as taxation, the management of prisons, municipal institutions, licencing, company incorporation, marriages, the protection of both property and civil rights, the administration of justice, the spending of funds earmarked for territorial purposes and education. A. NUMBERED FILES

The registry system of the Yukon Territorial Government was one in which files were numbered consecutively as each was created.

1. Numbered files, main series, 1894-1951, 48 feet, Volumes 1-9 (new numbering system) & Volumes 6-64 (old numbering system).
 - Registry files ranging from 6 to 36601.
 - Within this series there are many files concerning applications for purchase of land.
2. Numbered files, second series, 1899-1949, 1ft. 4 inches, Volumes 65-66.
 - Registry files ranging from 20 to 3525.

B. SUBJECT FILES

1897-1949, 8 feet 4 inches, Volumes 67-76.

This series of subject files consists of the many files which cannot be identified with a registry number or the many pieces of correspondence and forms that have been grouped together under subjects. The principal subjects are: Public Health, Customs, Communications, Territorial Promotion, Land Entitlement, Post Office, Immigration, Surveying, Timber Berths, Wood Reports, Steamships, etc.

Within these subject files are included three types of applications for which additional finding aids were prepared. They include:

1. Applications for Town Lots in Dawson, 1898, 4 inches, Volume 74.

These applications made to the Dominion Lands Agent for land in Dawson are arranged alphabetically by names of applicants. A listing is available which gives the name of the applicant, date of the applications, and the Lot-Block indication in each case.

2. Applications for Liquor Licenses, 1898-1901. 9 inches, Volume 75.

Applications from individuals or trading companies seeking permission to obtain a license to sell liquor, to obtain a hotel license, or to transfer or renew these licenses.

With these applications there are:

- Inspection reports, usually by N.W.M.P. officer, describing the establishment and recommending whether the license should be granted. A rough sketch sometimes accompanies the description.
- Covering letters from the police officer transmitting the inspection report to the license inspector.
- Receipts to the applicant from the license inspector.

- The applications are arranged alphabetically by names of applicants and a listing is provided.

At the end of the series there are miscellaneous documents to the Chief Inspector of Licenses. Subjects include drunkenness charges, and the importation of liquor. There are also various certificates and declarations. These documents have been arranged by names of persons or companies involved and a listing has been provided.

3. Applications for Marriage Licenses, 1901-1915. 7 inches. Volume 76.

Applications for marriage licenses made to the Issuer of Licenses, 1901-1915. Each application, which indicates the names and the ages of both parties, was assigned a number and they are arranged numerically from 193-1000. At the beginning of the series are two applications numbered 159 & 172, and at the end of the series are three unnumbered applications.
