Harrington's Store was built in 1902, as the frenzy of the Klondike Gold Rush was fading and Dawson City was becoming a more established community. William Harrington ran a grocery store on the ground floor, with living space on the second floor. When you visit now, you'll see photos of Dawson City over the years in a Parks Canada exhibit about Dawson's past.
