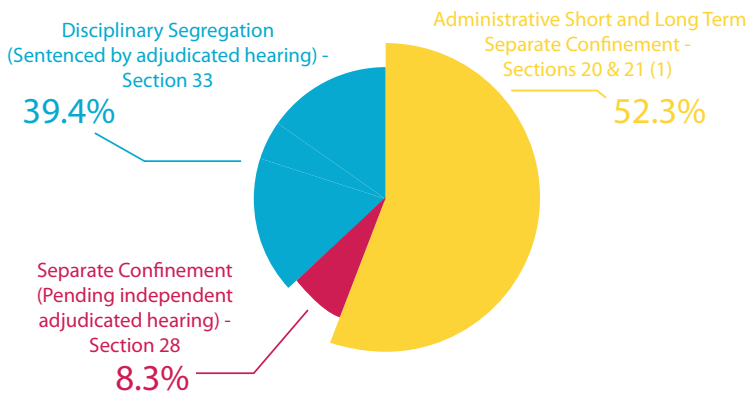


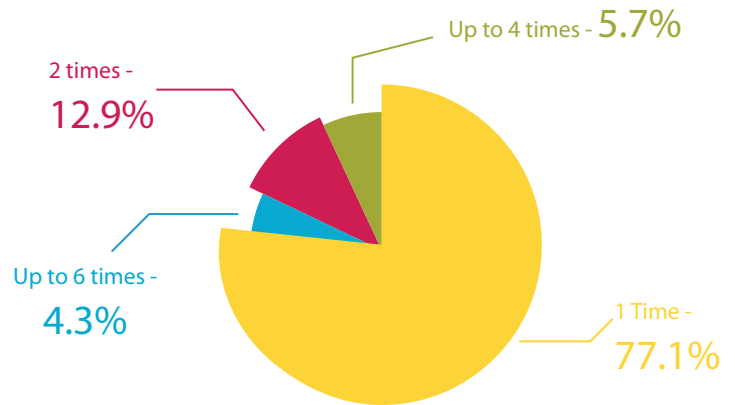

Separate Confinement Instances per Individual



- Out of 681 admissions to WCC in 2014, 49 individuals were segregated for a total of 109 instances.
- There were 27466 bed days in 2014. Of those, 815 were served in segregation by 49 individuals.
- Eight individuals voluntarily confined themselves in 16 instances for a total of 297 bed days.
- The majority of separately confined individuals are held in the Segregation Unit, which is designed for safe, secure housing of inmates.

Separate Confinement Instances by Days Confined

Note: Due to a combination of disciplinary segregation and administrative separate confinement, one individual remained confined for a total of 81 days without interruption in 2014. Any absence from WCC while administratively confined or segregated for disciplinary reasons, constitutes an interruption.

** One individual totaled two instances.
