



Separate Confinement by Corrections Act and Regulations Section

- There were 349 individuals incarcerated in 2016 on 620 WCC admissions.
- There were 32,155 bed days in 2016. Of those, 526 (1.6%) were served in the Segregation Unit by 70 individuals.
- 11 individuals voluntarily confined themselves in 2016.
- Under the Corrections Act, separate confinement is defined in sections 20, 21, 22 (voluntary) and 28.
 Segregation is referred to in section 33 as a disciplinary penalty administered by independent hearing adjudicators. All individuals who are separately confined under the above sections retain access to visitors, legal counsel and elders.
