Wholesale Trade, April 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – June 18, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for April 2020 was \$11.1 million. This represents a decrease of \$2.4 million, or 17.7%, compared to April 2019, and a decrease of \$3.1 million, or 22.1%, compared to March 2020.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in April 2020 decreased 24.3% compared to April 2019, and decreased 23.2% compared to March 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January to April), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$42.6 million. This represents a decrease of \$5.5 million, or 11.5%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$48.1 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales decreased 4.5% over this time period.
