



Wholesale Trade, January 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada — March 23, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for January 2020 was \$8.0 million. This represents an increase of \$260,000, or 3.3%, compared to January 2019, and a decrease of \$572,000, or 6.6%, compared to December 2019.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in January 2020 increased 3.0% compared to January 2019, and decreased 2.9% compared to December 2019.

On a **revised** annual basis, wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$151.3 million. This represents a decrease of \$52.4 million, or 25.7%, compared to 2018 (\$203.7 million). Canada's wholesale sales increased 2.2% over this time period.
