Wholesale Trade, January 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada - March 12, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for January 2021 was \$10.7 million. This represents an increase of \$2.1 million, or 23.9%, compared to January 2020, and a decrease of \$2.2 million, or 17.0%, compared to December 2020.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in January 2021 increased 2.5% compared to January 2021, and decreased 7.5% compared to December 2020.

On a **revised** annual basis, the 2020 wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$160.7 million. Yukon's 2020 annual wholesale sales increased \$7.0 million, or 4.6%, compared to 2019 (\$153.7 million). Canada's wholesale sales decreased 1.0% in 2020.
