

Investment in Building Construction, February 2020

Released by Statistics Canada — April 21, 2020

The estimated investment (seasonally adjusted) in building construction in Yukon for February 2020 was \$31.9 million, an increase of \$8.9 million, or 38.4%, compared to the figure for February 2019. Compared to the figure for January 2020, the February 2020 investment in building construction in Yukon increased by \$253,700, or 0.8%.

Nationally, investment in building construction (seasonally adjusted) in February 2020 increased 11.2% compared to the figure for February 2019, and increased 1.3% compared to the figure for January 2020.

On a **year-to-date** basis from January through February of 2020, the total value of investment in building construction in Yukon was \$63.5 million. This represents an increase of \$18.7 million, or 41.7%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$44.8 million); residential investment was up \$16.4 million and non-residential investment was up \$2.3 million.
