



Investment in Building Construction, January 2020

Released by Statistics Canada — March 23, 2020

The estimated investment (seasonally adjusted) in building construction in Yukon for January 2020 was \$31.5 million, an increase of \$9.8 million, or 44.8%, compared to the revised figure for January 2019. Compared to the figure for December 2019, the January 2020 investment in building construction in Yukon decreased by \$163,100, or 0.5%.

Nationally, investment in building construction (seasonally adjusted) in January 2020 increased 10.0% compared to the revised figure for January 2019, and increased 0.5% compared to the figure for December 2019.

On a **revised annual** basis, the total value of investment in building construction in Yukon for 2019 was \$315.7 million. This represents an increase of \$25.8 million, or 8.9%, compared to the 2018 total (\$289.9 million); residential investment was down \$2.6 million and non-residential investment was up \$28.4 million.
