

Investment in Building Construction, January 2021

Released by Statistics Canada – March 8, 2021

The estimated investment (seasonally adjusted) in building construction in Yukon for January 2021 was \$24.3 million, a decrease of \$4.3 million, or 15.0%, compared to the figure for January 2020. Compared to the figure for December 2020, the January 2021 investment in building construction in Yukon decreased by \$419,000, or 1.7%.

Nationally, investment in building construction (seasonally adjusted) in January 2021, increased 6.1% compared to the figure for January 2020 and increased 2.8% compared to the figure for December 2020.

On a **revised annual** basis, the total value of investment in building construction in Yukon for 2020 was \$349.7 million. This represents an increase of \$54.0 million, or 18.2%, compared to the 2019 total (\$295.8 million); residential investment was up \$65.7 million and non-residential investment was down \$11.8 million.
