

Retail Trade, June 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – August 20, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for June 2021 was \$86.8 million, an increase of \$5.8 million, or 7.1%, compared to June 2020. Yukon's June 2021 retail sales decreased by \$382,000, or 0.4%, compared to May 2021.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 6.9% in June 2021 compared to June 2020 and increased 4.1% compared to May 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January through June 2021), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$450.6 million. This represents an increase of \$52.2 million, or 13.1%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$398.3 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 18.5% over this time period.
