**32.9%** of the population aged 25 to 64 in the Yukon had a bachelor's degree or higher

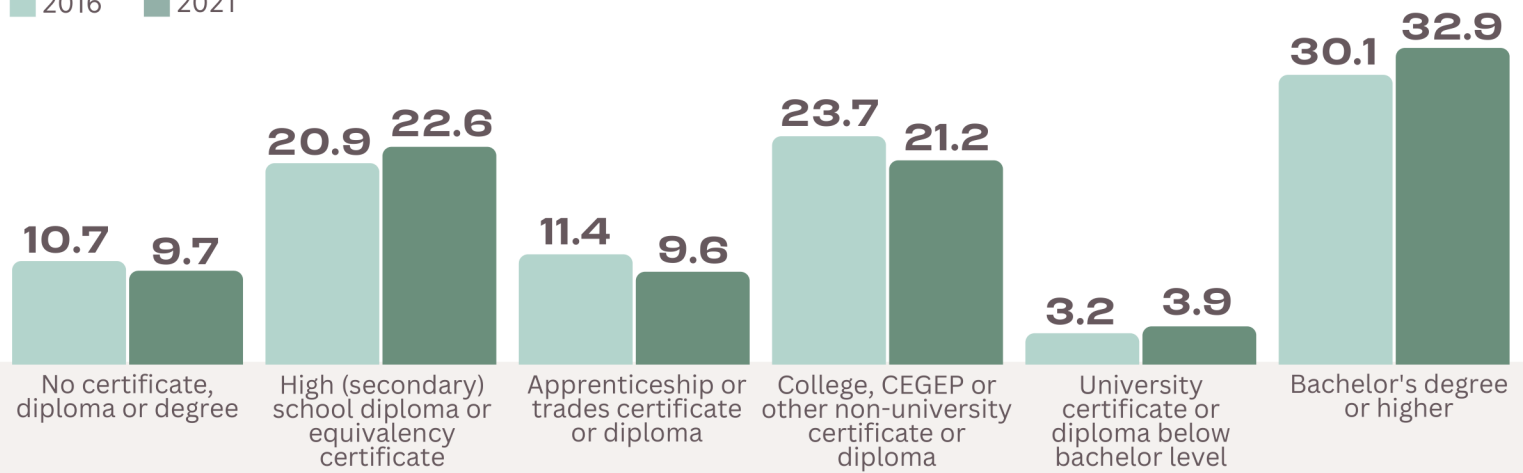
Within the population aged 25 to 64, the **top field of study** was:
