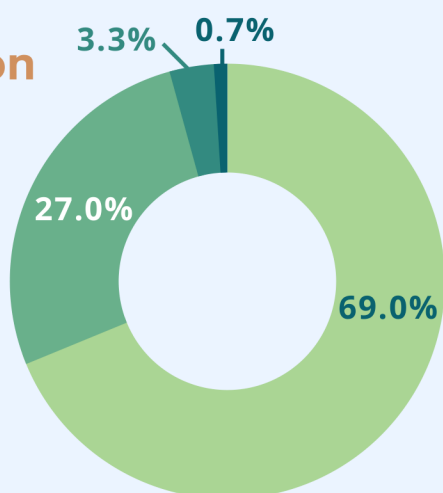

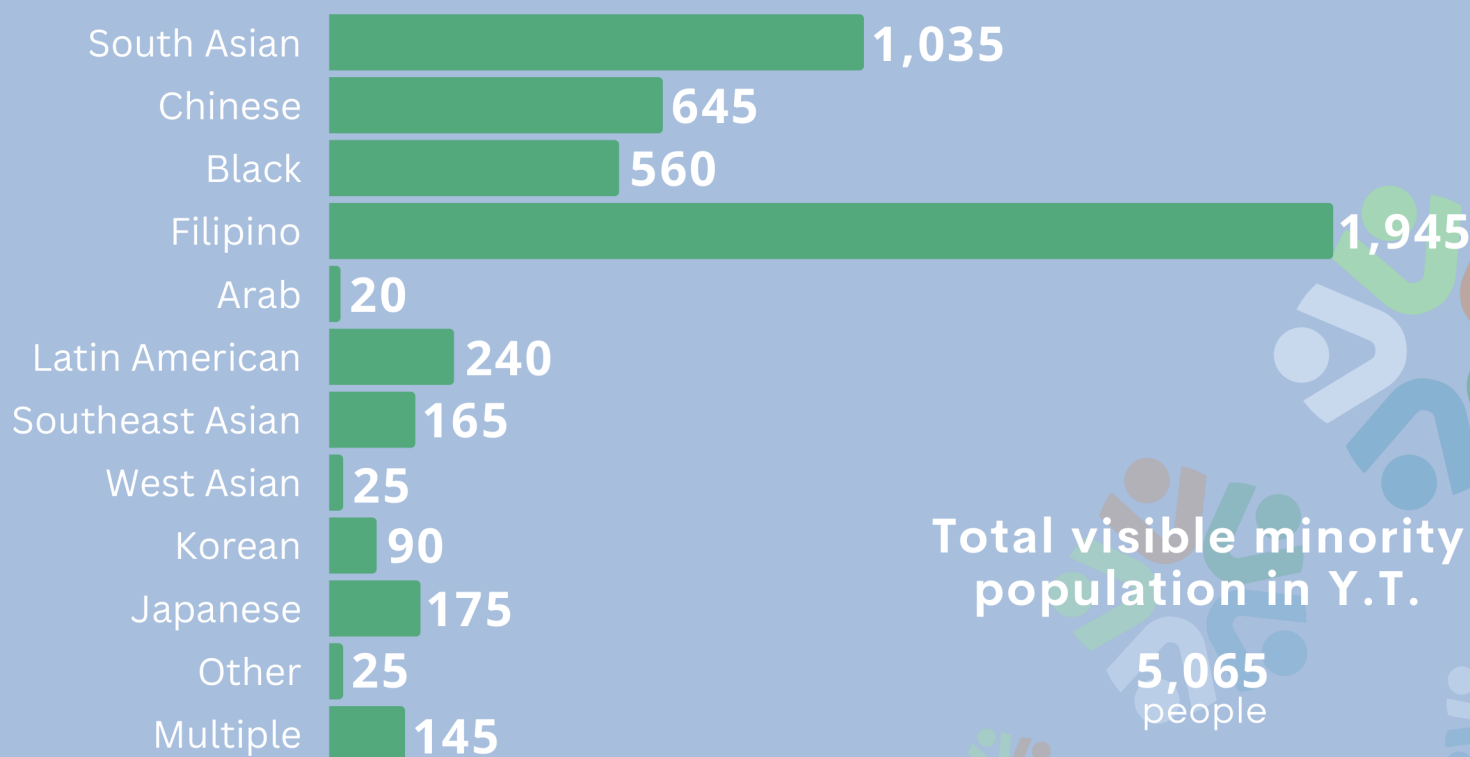

Breakdown by visible minority group in the Yukon

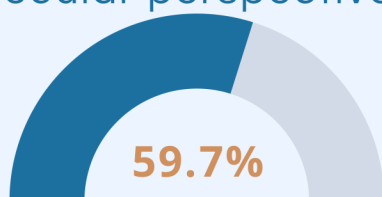

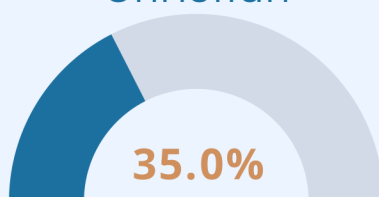

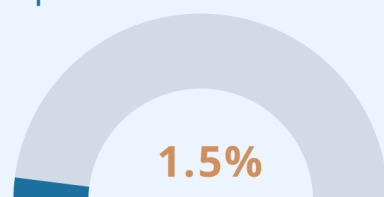
