Gross Domestic Product by Industry (GDP), 2023 (preliminary estimates)

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
According to preliminary estimates by Statistics Canada, Yukon's real GDP by Industry in 2023 totalled \$3,350.2 million (in chained 2017 dollars), an increase of 1.6%, following an increase of 5.8% in 2022. Yukon's real GDP growth rate (1.6%) was the fifth highest in Canada and 0.4 percentage points above the national GDP growth rate (1.2%).

The highest growth rate was recorded in Nunavut (3.4%) followed by Prince Edward Island (2.2%). In 2023, real GDP by industry growth was positive in all provinces and territories except Newfoundland and Labrador (-2.5%) and the Northwest Territories (-0.1%).

The provincial and territorial GDP by industry data at basic prices are chained volume estimates with 2017 as their
reference year. This means data for each industry and aggregate are obtained from a chained volume index
multiplied by the industry's value added in 2017.

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In 2023, Yukon's GDP in Goods-producing industries decreased by \$6.8 million, or 0.8%, while GDP in Services-producing industries increased by \$62.3 million, or 2.6% compared to 2022.

The sector of Yukon's economy that experienced the largest increase in real GDP was Public administration (\$13.9 million, or 1.8%), followed by Health care and social assistance (\$10.8 million, or 3.6%), and Real estate and rental and leasing (\$10.0 million, or 2.2%). The sector of Yukon's economy that experienced the largest decrease in real GDP was Mining, quarrying, and oil and gas extraction (\$3.2 million, or 0.9%).
