



Investment in Building Construction, April 2023

Released by Statistics Canada - June 15, 2023

The estimated investment (seasonally adjusted, <u>current dollars</u>) in building construction in Yukon for April 2023 was \$53.0 million, an increase of \$21.7 million, or 69.2%, compared to the figure for April 2022 (\$31.3 million). Compared to the figure for March 2023 (\$39.2 million), the April 2023 investment in building construction in Yukon increased by \$13.8 million, or 35.3%.

Nationally, investment in building construction (seasonally adjusted, <u>current dollars</u>) in April 2023, decreased 1.7% compared to the figure for April 2022 and increased 0.4% compared to the figure for March 2023.

On a **year-to-date** (January through April of 2023) basis, the total value of investment in building construction (<u>current dollars</u>) in Yukon was \$160.2 million. This represents an increase of \$34.8 million, or 27.7%, compared to the same time period in 2022 (\$125.4 million); residential investment (\$108.6 million) increased by \$23.0 million and non-residential investment (\$51.5 million) was up \$11.7 million.

In April 2023, on a <u>constant dollar</u> (2012=100) basis, investment in building construction was \$30.8 million, an increase of \$11.5 million, or 59.7%, compared to the figure for April 2022 (\$19.3 million). Compared to the figure for March 2023 (\$22.7 million), the April 2023 investment in building construction increased by \$8.0 million, or 35.4%.

Nationally, on a <u>constant dollar</u> (2012=100) basis, investment in building construction in April 2023 decreased 6.5%, compared to the figure for April 2022, and increased 2.3% from March 2023.


