Investment in Building Construction, December 2022

Released by Statistics Canada - February 13, 2023

The estimated investment (seasonally adjusted, <u>current dollars</u>) in building construction in Yukon for December 2022 was \$34.4 million, an increase of \$5.9 million, or 20.8%, compared to the figure for December 2021. Compared to the figure for November 2022 (\$32.9 million), the December 2022 investment in building construction in Yukon increased by \$1.5 million, or 4.5%.

Nationally, investment in building construction (seasonally adjusted, <u>current dollars</u>) in December 2022, increased 6.2% compared to the figure for December 2021 and decreased 1.3% compared to the figure for November 2022.

On an **annual** basis (January through December of 2022), the **preliminary** total value of investment in building construction (<u>current dollars</u>) in Yukon was \$371.1 million. This represents an increase of \$15.3 million, or 4.3%, compared to the same time period in 2021 (\$355.8 million); residential investment was down \$23.8 million and non-residential investment was up \$39.1 million.

On a <u>constant dollar</u> basis (2012=100), investment in building construction was \$20.2 million, an increase of \$1.5 million, or 8.2%, compared to the figure for December 2021. Compared to the figure for November 2022 (\$19.7 million), the December 2022 investment in building construction increased by \$530,000, or 2.7%.

Nationally, on a <u>constant dollar</u> basis (2012=100), investment in building construction decreased 5.4%, compared to the figure for December 2021, and decreased 2.0% from November 2022.

Investment in Building Construction, Constant Dollars² (seasonally adjusted), December 2022


