## **Investment in Building Construction, June 2022**

Released by Statistics Canada - August 12, 2022

The estimated investment (seasonally adjusted) in building construction in Yukon for June 2022 was \$20.0 million, a decrease of \$16.8 million, or 45.7%, compared to the figure for June 2021. Compared to the figure for May 2022, the June 2022 investment in building construction in Yukon decreased by \$3.7 million, or 15.5%.

Nationally, investment in building construction (seasonally adjusted) in June 2022, increased 12.2% compared to the figure for June 2021 and increased 0.3% compared to the figure for May 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January through June of 2022), the total value of investment in building construction in Yukon was \$163.7 million. This represents a decrease of \$5.9 million, or 3.5%, compared to the same time period in 2021 (\$169.6 million); residential investment was down \$17.8 million and non-residential investment was up \$11.9 million.
