





Labour Force Survey, August 2022


Released by Statistics Canada – September 9, 2022

In August 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 1.7%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.4%.

Compared to the figures for July 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (23,900) remained the same; the number of employed (23,500) increased by 200; and the number of unemployed (400) decreased by 200.
