Labour Force Survey, December 2021


Released by Statistics Canada – January 7, 2022

In December 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 2.8%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.9%.

Compared to the figures for November 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,600) increased by 700; the number of employed (24,000) increased by 800; and the number of unemployed (700) remained the same.
