## Labour Force Survey, December 2022

Released by Statistics Canada - January 6, 2023
In December 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.8\%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.0\%.

Compared to the figures for November 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force $(25,100)$ increased by 500 ; the number of employed $(23,800)$ increased by 400 ; the number of unemployed $(1,200)$ remained the same; and the unemployment rate decreased by 0.1 percentage point.

Compared to the figures for December 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force $(25,100)$ increased by 500 ; the number of employed $(23,800)$ remained unchanged; the number of unemployed $(1,200)$ increased by 500 ; and the unemployment rate increased by 2.0 percentage points.
