



Labour Force Survey, December 2022

Released by Statistics Canada – January 6, 2023

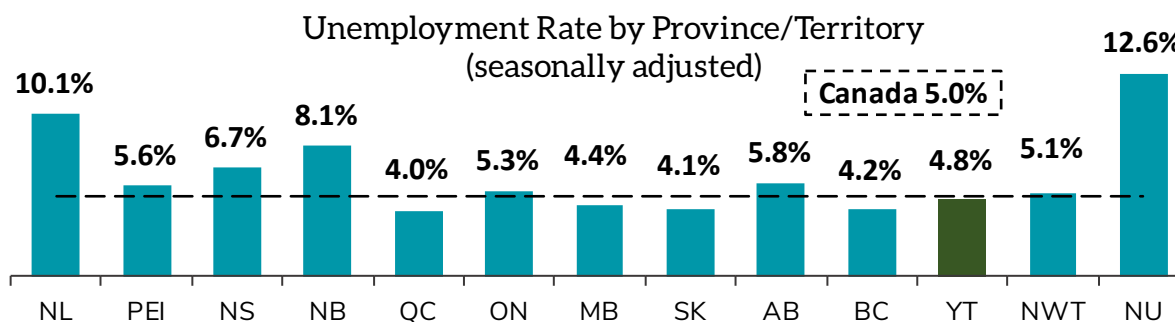
In December 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.8%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.0%.

Compared to the figures for November 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (25,100) increased by 500; the number of employed (23,800) increased by 400; the number of unemployed (1,200) remained the same; and the unemployment rate decreased by 0.1 percentage point.

Compared to the figures for December 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (25,100) increased by 500; the number of employed (23,800) remained unchanged; the number of unemployed (1,200) increased by 500; and the unemployment rate increased by 2.0 percentage points.
