

Labour Force Survey, January 2022

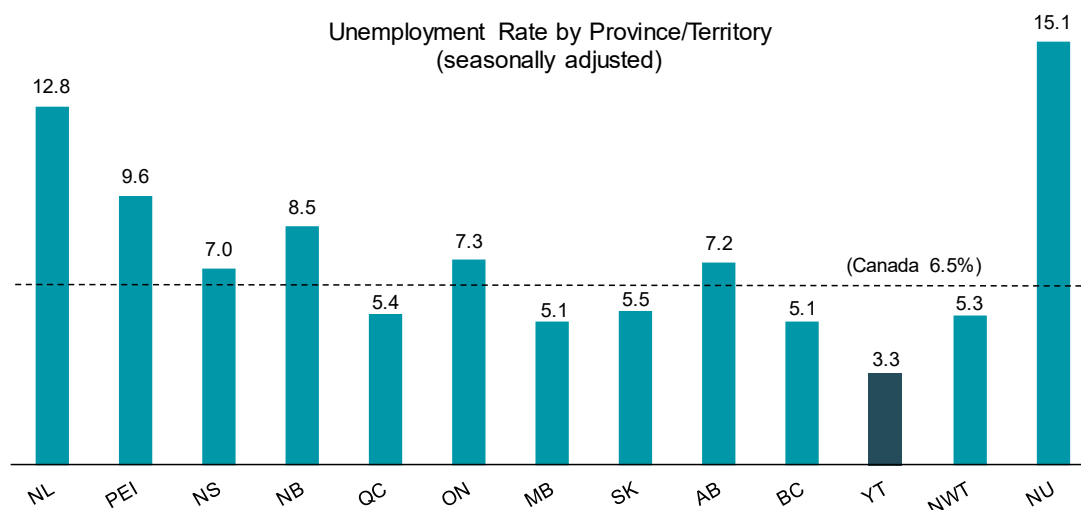
Released by Statistics Canada – February 4, 2022

In January 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.3%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 6.5%.

Compared to the figures for December 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,000) decreased by 600; the number of employed (23,100) decreased by 700; and the number of unemployed (800) increased by 100.

¹ All territories' monthly figures are based on three-month moving averages and are, therefore, not included in the overall figures for Canada.

² 'Change' is measured in percent, or percentage points, where applicable. Percentage points are the actual numerical difference between two percentages, such as: 10% - 8% = 2 percentage points.
