

Labour Force Survey, January 2024

Released by Statistics Canada – February 9, 2024

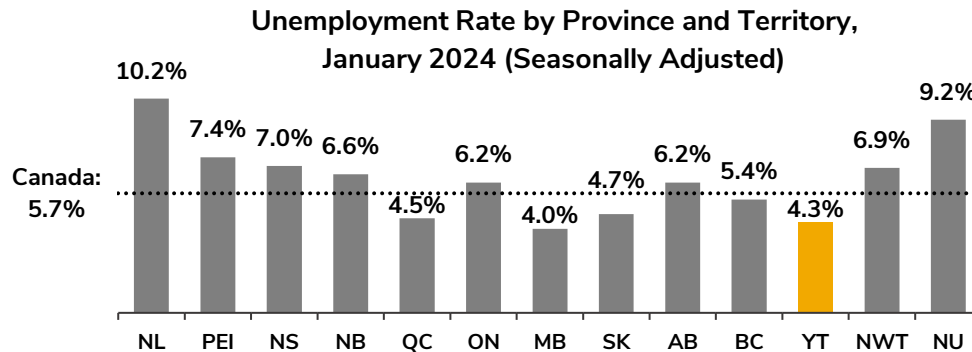
In January 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.3%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.7%.

Compared to the figures for December 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (25,400) decreased by 100; the number of employed (24,300) decreased by 200; the number of unemployed (1,100) increased by 100; and the unemployment rate increased by 0.4 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for January 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (25,400) increased by 1,200; the number of employed (24,300) increased by 1,000; the number of unemployed (1,100) increased by 200; and the unemployment rate increased by 0.6 percentage points.

¹ All territories' monthly figures are based on three-month moving averages and are, therefore, not included in the overall figures for Canada.

² 'Change' is measured in percent, or percentage points, where applicable. Percentage points are the actual numerical difference between two percentages, such as: 10% - 8% = 2 percentage points.

³ All estimates are rounded to the nearest hundred.
