

## Labour Force Survey, June 2022

Released by Statistics Canada – July 8, 2022

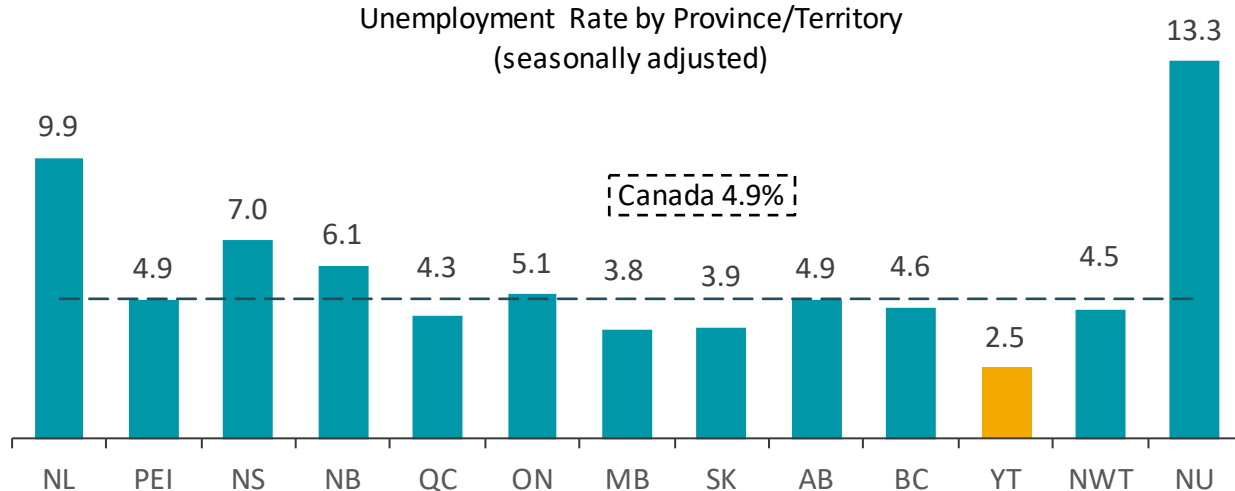
In June 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 2.5%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 4.9%.

Compared to the figures for May 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,100) decreased by 100; the number of employed (23,500) increased by 600; the number of unemployed (600) decreased by 700.
