



Labour Force Survey, June 2023

Released by Statistics Canada - July 7, 2023


In June 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.0%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.4%.

Compared to the figures for May 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,900) decreased by 300; the number of employed (24,000) decreased by 400; the number of unemployed (1,000) increased by 300; and the unemployment rate increased by 1.2 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for June 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,900) increased by 700; the number of employed (24,000) increased by 500; the number of unemployed (1,000) increased by 200; and the unemployment rate increased by 0.7 percentage points.
