

Labour Force Survey, March 2022

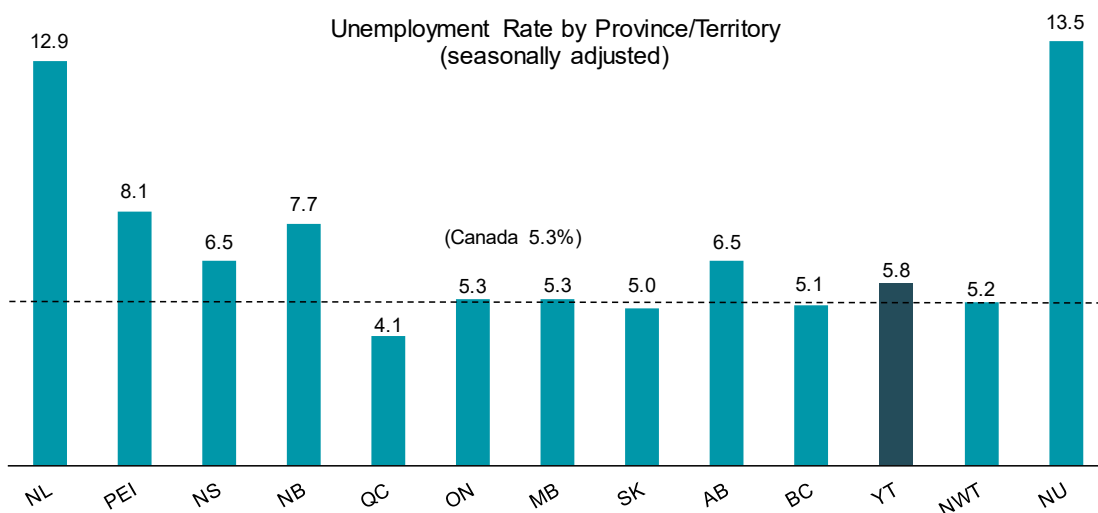
Released by Statistics Canada – April 8, 2022

In March 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.8%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.3%.

Compared to the figures for February 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,000) decreased by 200; the number of employed (22,600) decreased by 500; and the number of unemployed (1,400) increased by 300.
