## Labour Force Survey, March 2023

Released by Statistics Canada - April 6, 2023


In March 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 2.9%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.0%.

Compared to the figures for February 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (23,800) decreased by 100; the number of employed (23,100) increased by 100; the number of unemployed (700) decreased by 200; and the unemployment rate decreased by 0.9 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for March 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (23,800) decreased by 700; the number of employed (23,100) remained the same; the number of unemployed (700) decreased by 700; and the unemployment rate decreased by 2.8 percentage points.
