Labour Force Survey, March 2024

Released by Statistics Canada - April 5, 2024

In March 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.3%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 6.1%.

Compared to the figures for February 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (25,600) increased by 100; the number of employed (24,500) increased by 100; the number of unemployed (1,100) increased by 100; and the unemployment rate increased by 0.4 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for March 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (25,600) increased by 1,700; the number of employed (24,500) increased by 1,300; the number of unemployed (1,100) increased by 400; and the unemployment rate increased by 1.4 percentage points.
