



## Labour Force Survey, May 2022

Released by Statistics Canada – June 10, 2022

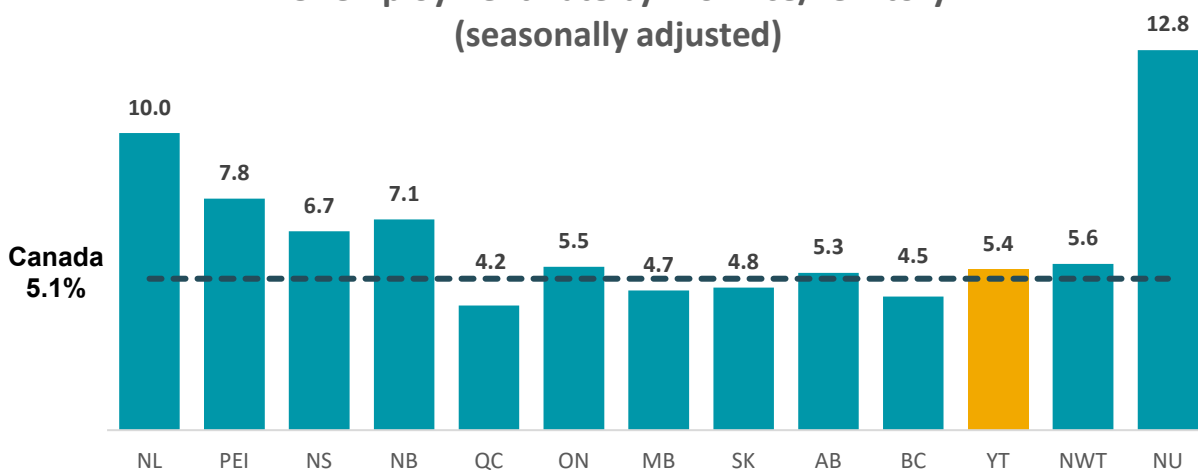
In May 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.4%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.1%.

Compared to the figures for April 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,200) decreased by 300; the number of employed (22,900) decreased by 300; and the number of unemployed (1,300) remained the same.
