



Labour Force Survey, May 2024

Released by Statistics Canada – June 7, 2024

In May 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.5%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 6.2%.

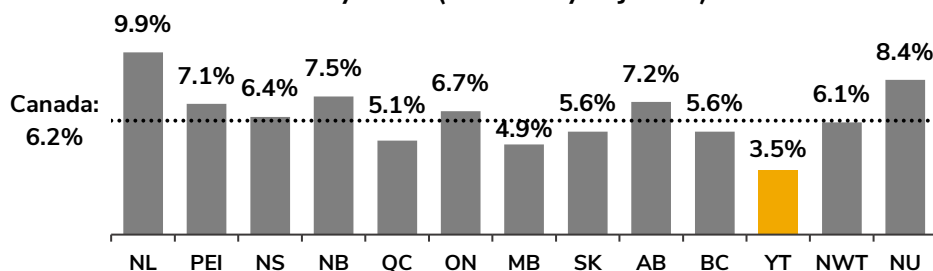
Compared to the figures for April 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (25,900) increased by 200; the number of employed (25,000) increased by 100; the number of unemployed (900) increased by 100; and the unemployment rate increased by 0.4 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for May 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (25,900) increased by 900; the number of employed (25,000) increased by 700; the number of unemployed (900) increased by 200; and the unemployment rate increased by 0.7 percentage points.
