Labour Force Survey, November 2021



In November 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 2.9%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 6.0%.

Compared to the figures for October 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (23,900) increased by 200; the number of employed (23,200) increased by 700; and the number of unemployed (700) decreased by 500.
