



Labour Force Survey, September 2023

Released by Statistics Canada – October 6, 2023

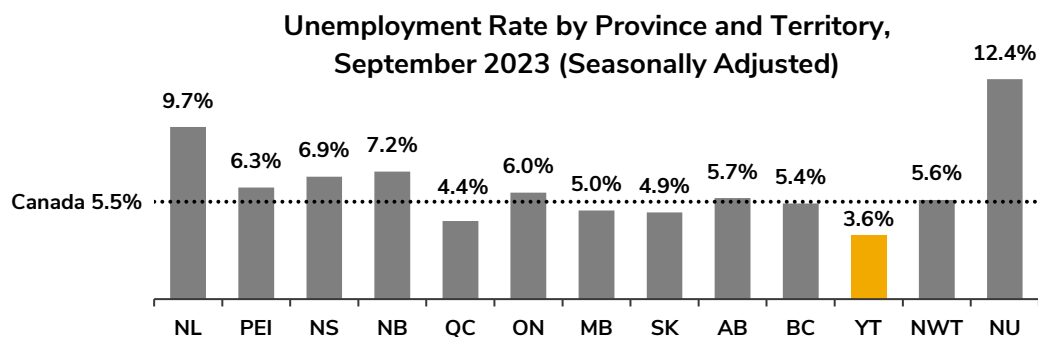
In September 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.6%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.5%.

Compared to the figures for August 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (25,100) increased by 400; the number of employed (24,100) increased by 500; the number of unemployed (900) decreased by 200; and the unemployment rate decreased by 0.9 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for September 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (25,100) increased by 1,000; the number of employed (24,100) increased by 800; the number of unemployed (900) increased by 100; and the unemployment rate increased by 0.3 percentage points.
