

## Retail Trade, August 2022 (preliminary)

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The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of retail sales in Yukon for August 2022 was \$99.0 million, an increase of \$11.0 million, or 12.5%, compared to \$87.9 million for August 2021. August 2022 retail sales increased by \$0.8 million, or 0.9%, compared to July 2022.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 8.7% in August 2022 compared to August 2021, and increased 0.4% compared to July 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January through August 2022), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$679.5 million. This represents an increase of \$45.8 million, or 7.2%, compared to the same time period in 2021 (\$633.7 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 9.1% over this time period.
