





Retail Trade, December 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada - February 18, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for December 2021 was \$81.0 million, an increase of \$2.2 million, or 2.7%, compared to December 2020. Yukon's December 2021 retail sales increased by \$5.3 million, or 7.0%, compared to November 2021.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 8.6% in December 2021 compared to December 2020 and increased 1.0% compared to November 2021.

On a preliminary year-to-date basis (January through December 2021), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$946.2 million. This represents an increase of \$61.1 million, or 6.9%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$885.2 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 11.6% over this time period.
