

Retail Trade, December 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – February 21, 2023

The retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon for December 2022 were \$85.1 million, an increase of \$3.0 million, or 3.7%, compared to December 2021 (\$82.1 million). Yukon's December 2022 retail sales increased by \$1.9 million, or 2.2%, compared to November 2022.

Nationally, retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 7.0% in December 2022 compared to December 2021, and increased 1.4% compared to November 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January through December 2022), retail sales in Yukon totalled \$1,026.0 million, an increase of \$62.6 million, or 6.5%, compared to the same period in 2021 (\$963.5 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 8.1% over this time period.
