Retail Trade, January 2023 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – March 24, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for January 2023 was \$75.2 million, an increase of \$6.6 million, or 9.6%, compared to January 2022 (\$68.6 million). January 2023 retail sales decreased by \$13.6 million, or 15.4%, compared to December 2022 (\$88.9 million).

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 5.5% in January 2023 compared to January 2022, and decreased 20.1% compared to December 2022.

On a **revised** annual basis, 2022 retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$1,085.2 million. This annual total represents an increase of \$74.0 million, or 7.3%, compared to 2021 (\$1,011.2 million). Canada's annual retail sales increased 8.3% over this time period.
