



## Retail Trade, June 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – August 19, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of retail sales in Yukon for June 2022 was \$105.0 million, an increase of \$17.6 million, or 20.1%, compared to \$87.4 million for June 2021. June 2022 retail sales increased by \$14.2 million, or 15.6%, compared to May 2022.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 11.1% in June 2022 compared to June 2021, and increased 0.1% compared to May 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January through June 2022), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$484.3 million. This represents an increase of \$28.2 million, or 6.2%, compared to the same time period in 2021 (\$456.0 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 9.8% over this time period.
