

## Retail Trade, May 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – July 22, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of retail sales in Yukon for May 2022 was \$91.1 million, an increase of \$3.1 million, or 3.5%, compared to \$88.1 million for May 2021. May 2022 retail sales increased by \$11.4 million, or 14.4%, compared to April 2022.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 15.3% in May 2022 compared to May 2021, and increased 11.7% compared to April 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January through May 2022), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$379.6 million. This represents an increase of \$11.0 million, or 3.0%, compared to the same time period in 2021 (\$368.6 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 9.5% over this time period.
