





Retail Trade, November 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – January 21, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for November 2021 was \$75.5 million, a decrease of \$575,000, or 0.8%, compared to November 2020. Yukon's November 2021 retail sales decreased by \$7.5 million, or 9.1%, compared to October 2021.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 6.9% in November 2021 compared to November 2020 and increased 1.8% compared to October 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January through November 2021), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$864.9 million. This represents an increase of \$58.6 million, or 7.3%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$806.3 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 11.9% over this time period.
