

Retail Trade, October 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – December 21, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for October 2021 was \$83.1 million, a decrease of \$1.1 million, or 1.3%, compared to October 2020. Yukon's October 2021 retail sales increased by \$914,000, or 1.1%, compared to September 2021.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 3.6% in October 2021 compared to October 2020 and increased 2.3% compared to September 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January through October 2021), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$789.5 million. This represents an increase of \$59.3 million, or 8.1%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$730.2 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 12.4% over this time period.
