



Retail Trade, October 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – December 20, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of retail sales in Yukon for October 2022 was \$89.4 million, an increase of \$4.3 million, or 5.0%, compared to \$85.2 million for October 2021. Yukon's October 2022 retail sales increased by \$1.3 million, or 1.5%, compared to September 2022.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 5.1% in October 2022 compared to October 2021, and increased 1.1% compared to September 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January through October 2022), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$856.8 million. This represents an increase of \$53.5 million, or 6.7%, compared to the same time period in 2021 (\$803.3 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 8.4% over this time period.
