



Retail Trade, September 2023 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – November 24, 2023

The retail sales (unadjusted for seasonality) in Yukon for September 2023 were \$100.8 million, an increase of \$7.4 million, or 7.9%, compared to September 2022 (\$93.4 million). Yukon's September 2023 retail sales decreased by \$20.2 million, or 16.7%, compared to August 2023 (\$121.0 million).

Nationally, retail sales (unadjusted for seasonality) increased 2.4% in September 2023 compared to September 2022, and decreased 3.8% compared to August 2023.

On a year-to-date basis (January through September 2023), retail sales (unadjusted for seasonality) in Yukon totalled \$883.6 million, an increase of \$69.6 million, or 8.5%, compared to the same period in 2022 (\$814.0 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 2.3% over this time period.
