

Wholesale Trade, April 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – June 16, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for April 2022 was \$17.9 million. This represents an increase of \$2.7 million, or 18.0%, compared to April 2021, and an increase of \$1.3 million, or 7.9%, compared to March 2022.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in April 2022 increased 9.7% compared to April 2021, and decreased 7.6% compared to March 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January to April 2022), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$60.2 million. This represents an increase of \$1.9 million, or 3.2%, compared to the revised figure from the same time period in 2021 (\$58.4 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 13.7% over this time period.
